The British Biophysical Society wants to share information and news about UK and global Biophysics activities by email. We can only do this if you would like us to.

Your privacy is very important to us, which is why we make sure you are always in control of what we do with your personal information.

The following information will be collected in order to provide you with the BBS Newsgroup service:

- Name
- E-mail address

Your data (name and email address) will be processed to create an electronic record that is subsequently used for the distribution of BBS Newsgroup emails. The data will be stored on JISCMail servers. The JISCMail privacy statement is available at <https://www.jiscmail.ac.uk/policyandsecurity/index.html#9>. Your data will also be used to assist the BBS with statistical analysis of subscription numbers.

Your data will be used for the purpose of contacting you to distribute information from the BBS Newsgroup only.

We will never pass your personal details to any parties outside the BBS for the purpose of marketing unless you have previously provided us with your informed and specific consent.

We will ensure that we obtain your express consent before we contact you by any method for any purpose.

We will make sure our contact with you is relevant, based upon the preference information you give us.

You can change your contact preferences at any time. All you need to do is contact us at BBS@JISCMAIL.AC.UK. Your personal information will be stored safely and will remain secure at all times.

No statistical information which identifies you personally will be published.

No personal information will be kept any longer than necessary in order to fulfil the purpose it was collected for. If you ask us to, by unsubscribing from the list, it will be deleted. You can unsubscribe by following the link at the bottom of every newsgroup email, or by emailing BBS@JISCMAIL.AC.UK.

We will always delete your personal information if requested by you to do so.
