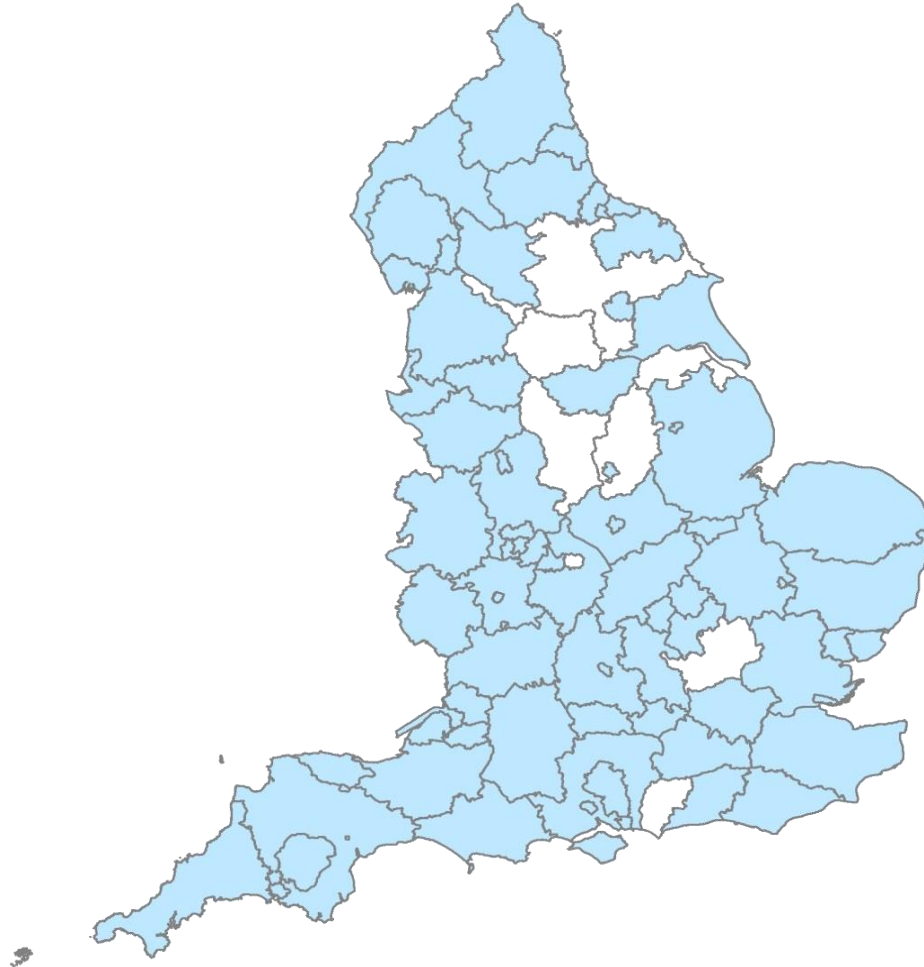

Blue = HER responded to the Survey

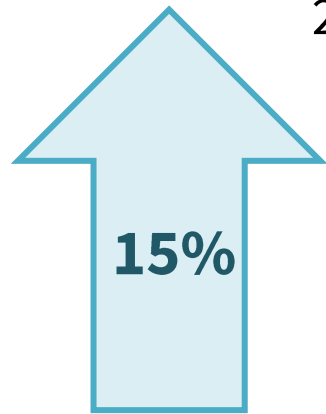

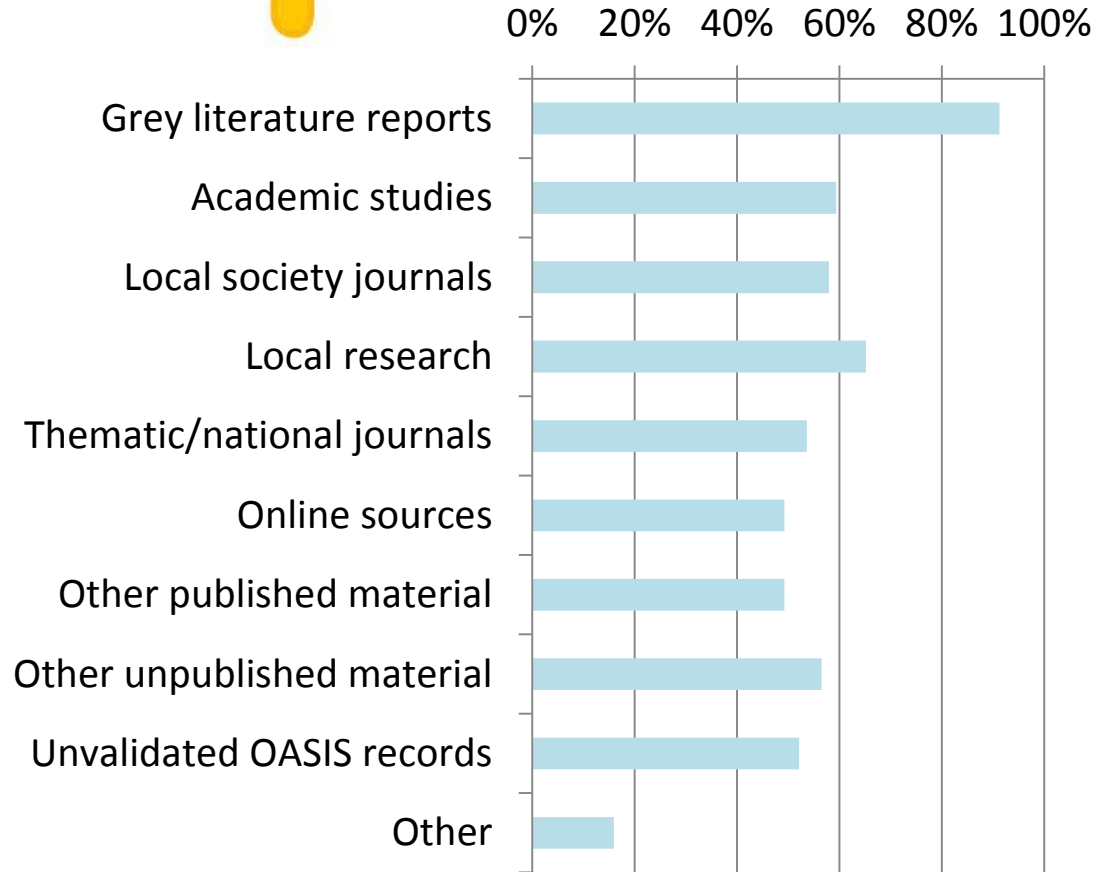
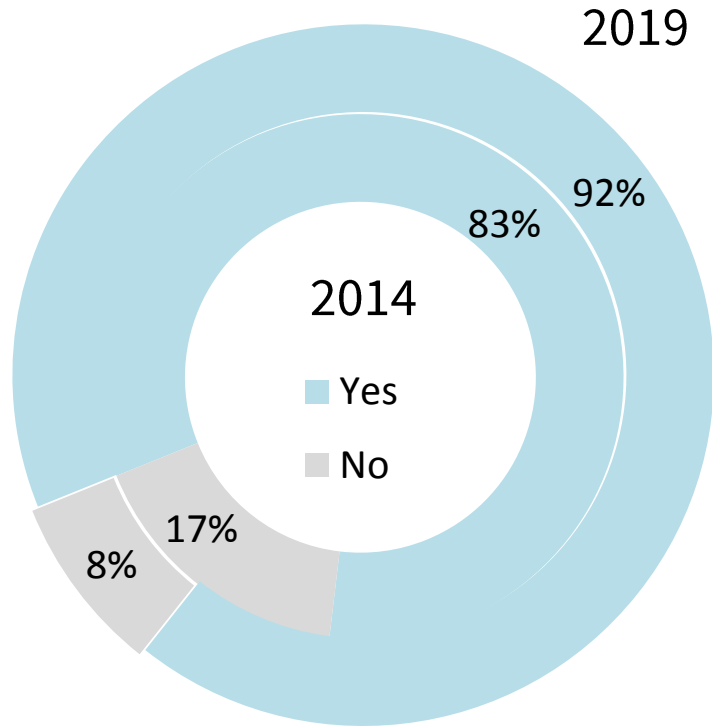


Record Density (km²)

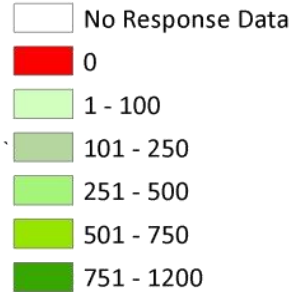
