A quick reminder

- Current OASIS form dates to 2003/4
 - 31,000+ records from England
 - 33,566 reports from England transferred to ADS

 Stage 1 (completed 2015) looked at user requirements for a new form

Stage 2 is the redevelopment project



A quick reminder

- Use of modern technologies to facilitate accurate and consistent data
- Easy to use
- Flexible workflows
 - OASIS Lite versus OASIS Standard
- Simple instant transfer of reports into ADS Library
- Records always open!



Timescales

Database and Java framework

Pre-Alpha testing in Autumn 2018

Alpha testing Spring 2019

Public beta March 2020



What have we done?

- A new database is in place (PostgreSQL + PostGIS)
- New data structure
 - Record less core data (but record it better!)
 - Ability to record more for certain projects(OASIS+)
- Java application (i.e. the form) in place
- Workflows mapped (i.e. what happens when!)

- Mapping old terms to existing heritage thesauri
 - FISH Event Types Thesaurus
 - FISH Archaeological Objects Thesaurus
 - FISH Thesaurus of Monument Types
 - Historic England Periods Authority File




What have we done?

- Mapping old data to new wordlists
 - Reason for investigation
 - Protection Status
 - Archive component
 - Funder type
 - Development type
 - Associated ID type

Mapping


- OS admin area
- HER area
- Geology
- ResearchFramework
- Museums





NLP for reports

- Terms extracted from report file (and title and abstract)
- Training data based on mapping exercise
- So for example we know that connolly1-301468 has:
 - ANIMAL BONES
 - POTTERY
 - FISHPOND





Research Frameworks

- Highlight spatially relevant records
- Incorporate research questions
 - Allow user to select their project as answering specific question
- More ambitious: tie in vocabulary terms to research questions
 - e.g. EARLY MEDEIVAL MONASTERY WARWICKSHIRE = ????
