### Theme

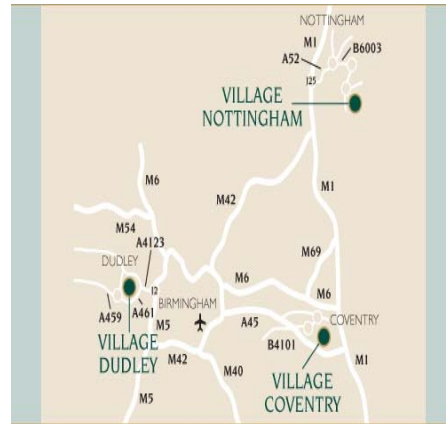
