GEM one day workshop Day 2 - 22nd June 04

The one day workshop will focus on Gender Evaluation Methodology (GEM) and explore how technology can be embedded into women's organisations using a gender analysis.

GEM provides users with an overview of the evaluation process (including links to general evaluation resources) and outlines suggested strategies and methodologies for incorporating a gender analysis throughout an evaluation process.

GEM is not simply an evaluation tool. It can also be used to ensure that a gender concerns are integrated into a project planning process.
