Wild@Ace 2004, Workshop on Industry and Labor Dynamics – the Agent-Based Computational Economics Approach, will be held in December 3-4, 2004 in Turin, Italy at LABORatorio Riccardo Revelli.

This is the second Wild@Ace event, jointly organized by LABORatorio Revelli, the University of Turin – Department of Economics, and the Social Interaction Economics and Computing group (SIEC). The theme of the conference is the conjunction between a broad area of interest, namely Labor Economics and Industrial Organization, and the agent-based simulation approach. Wild@Ace 2003 was the first event ever with this specific focus, and was attended by a great number of internationally recognised scholars.

- Validation and Calibration
- Agent-Based Microsimulation
- Micro-econometric foundations of agents' behavior
