- \* Decision analysis, risk analysis, probability, stochastic processes
- \* Complex systems, systems analysis, optimization

An earned Ph.D., evidence of the ability to pursue a research program, and a strong commitment to graduate and undergraduate teaching are required. A successful candidate will be expected to teach courses at the graduate and undergraduate levels and to build and lead a team of graduate students in Ph.D. research.

Applications should include a curriculum vitae, statements of research and teaching interests, any completed research papers, an official graduate transcript (if available), and the names of at least four references. Candidates are requested to ask references to send their letters directly to our search committee. The letters should be sent in as soon as possible, but no later than the application deadline.
