I guess the best thing to look at is the stats for your own site. You can grow

1. People with fully DOM compliant browsers (browsers that properly support CSS like IE 6 and Mozilla)
2. People with legacy browsers that provide some compliancy - Netscape 4
3. People with browser that have no CSS support - Text browsers, speech browsers
4. People using alternative devices with different screen requirements - Mobile devices, etc. You can build a web site without it being cut off!

Building with style sheets allows you to separate the content from the design and create different versions of the site tailored to their needs. So I guess what you need to do is to test and ascertain how many people from those different categories are hitting
