Teaching duties include Ba/Ms studies in Business Information Systems, Industrial Engineering, Finance and Business Mathematics as well as Mobility and Transportation.

The successful candidate will represent the field of Information Management in research funding and industrial partnerships. Interdisciplinary cooperation with Engineering and Computer Sciences within the Technische Universität Braunschweig is expected.

Requirements for applicants are a doctoral degree and an outstanding academic track record (habilitation or comparable scientific accomplishments) in research and teaching as well as evidence of strong pedagogic and didactic skills, c.f. §25 Niedersächsisches Hochschulgesetz.

The Technische Universität Braunschweig is an equal opportunity employer dedicated to increasing the proportion of its female faculty members. Qualified women are especially encouraged to apply. Female candidates and applicants with physical disabilities will be preferentially considered in cases of equivalent qualifications.

Employment will be as a civil servant (Beamte/r). Applicants aged 45 or older will be employed as a state employee (Angestellte/r) unless they already hold employment as a civil servant.
