From M1 South - leave the M1 at exit 17 and join M45. Follow signs for Coventry (S) and Birmingham A45 until you join the A46. Follow signs for Warwick, then slip road for Kenilworth and Leamington Spa (A452). At roundabout follow signs for Leamington Spa then after roughly 300 yards turn right at crossroads, the hotel is on the left.

From M1 North - leave M1 at exit 21 and join M69. Take A46 for Warwick, follow signs for Warwick, then slip road for Kenilworth and Leamington Spa A452. At roundabout follow signs for Leamington Spa then after roughly 300 yards turn right at crossroads, the hotel is on the left.

From M6 North - leave M6 at exit 4, A446 Coventry and Warwick. Follow A452 Coventry and Birmingham Airport. Stay on the A452 which will take you through Balsall Common and Kenilworth town centre. At roundabout follow signs for Leamington Spa then after roughly 300 yards turn right at crossroads, the hotel is on the left.

From M6 South - Leave M6 at exit 2 and join A46, follow signs for Warwick, then road Kenilworth and Leamington Spa A452. At roundabout follow signs for Leamington Spa then after roughly 300 yards turn right at crossroads, the hotel is on the left.

From M40 North and South - Leave M40 at exit 15, A46 for Coventry, then A452 Kenilworth and Leamington Spa. At roundabout follow signs for Leamington Spa then after roughly 300 yards turn right at crossroads, the hotel is on the left.
