**Aims**

The introduction of intensive care follow-up clinics has drawn attention to the adverse legacy of a critical care illness among a proportion of those who survive. Even patients who have spent a relatively short time in an intensive care unit can be traumatised by the event. This conference will address the physical, psychological and neurocognitive aspects of what has been termed “ICU syndrome”, with particular emphasis on identification of the problem of methods and treatment and rehabilitation into the community.
