Joseph S. Nye, Jr. is University Distinguished Service Professor and the Sultan of Oman Professor of International Relations at Harvard University. He served as Assistant Secretary of Defence for International Security Affairs and Chair of the National Intelligence Council in the Clinton administration, and Deputy Under Secretary of State for Security Assistance, Science and Technology in the Carter administration. Most recently, he is the author of *Understanding International Conflict*, 6th edition (2007); *Soft Power* (2004); and *The Power Game: A Washington Novel* (2004).

Sir Adam Roberts **KCMG MA FBA** is the Montague Burton Professor of International Relations and a Fellow of Balliol College at the University of Oxford. He is a member of the Council of the International Institute for Strategic Studies, London, and of the UK Defence Academy Advisory Board. He is an Honorary Fellow of the London School of Economics & Political Science and of St Antony's College, Oxford.
