Workshops at Wakefield Museum KS2 Victorian Schoolroom Role-play experience – Wakefield Museum



Science Week Activities 2008

The Learning and Access team have developed the following two workshops in conjunction with National Science Week 2008.



KS2 The Art of Science – Wakefield Art Gallery

This workshop allows children to explore the art of science through colourful experiments lead by the learning and access officer.

KS2 Real Romans – Pontefract Museum
