

Scope has found that nearly a third of people with communication impairments could not get funding from a statutory source for their communication aids. Many disabled people are left without any means to communicate even the most basic of wishes, let alone tell someone they love them.

We believe that communication is a basic human right and that everyone should get the support and equipment that they need to communicate.
