Innovation in Placement Assessment – E-Portfolios for Learning and Placement Stable Block 1, Charles Freers Campus, De Montfort University, Leicester Friday 9 May (11am-3pm) £50/£75

This event will see the presentation of the ASET funded research project 'Are E-Portfolios an Asset to Learning and Placements?', conducted by researchers in the Business and Nursing Schools at DMU. This report will cover topics including the context of e-learning and the role of portfolios in student learning and assessment, the results of a national survey of placement units concerning the topics, a review of existing e-portfolio packages and recommendations on the added value of them for innovative assessment of placements.

In addition Profile, a working web-based e-portfolio tool which provides students on placements with a means to document their learning and claim academic credit for their work, will also be demonstrated by its designer Dr Stephen Gomez from UWE. A working party with representatives from ASET, UCEA and USHA are currently revising the official UUK recommended 'Health and Safety Guidance for the Placement of HE Students'. This event is designed to ensure the purpose and process of this work is transparent and that ASET is accountable for its mandate of representing all UK placement professionals (USHA will be holding a similar event for the Health and Safety Managers which it represents).

The full draft document will be made available and ASET's representatives on the working party will explain it, collect comments and feedback and answer questions on it. The final guidance will then be published in November.

The guidance will affect matters such as pre-placement preparation of students, the approval of placements and placement visits and will seek to introduce a more risk-based approach to procedures.
