The Geoscience Faculty of the University of Tübingen invites applications for a professorship in General Geology, starting October 1, 2009.

The chair holder has to represent the entire field of geology with an emphasis on geodynamics and geosystem modelling in both research and teaching. Research activities should focus on geodynamic processes at the interface between surface and crustal interiors. Field-based and analytical research should be augmented by numerical modelling.

In addition to international research activities the successful candidate is expected to build up a mainly externally funded research group and to engage in interdisciplinary collaborations with other research groups within the faculty.

Requirements include a post-doctoral qualification ("Habilitation") or equivalent qualifications, and a commitment to excellence in teaching.

The University of Tübingen is an equal opportunity employer and aims to increase the number of women in research and teaching. Qualified women are therefore strongly encouraged to apply.

Qualified persons with a disability will be given preference.
