The research consortium NEUROSCAN (NeuroScienceAndNorms: Ethical and Legal Aspects of Norms in Neuroimaging) is a trinational project funded for three years by the BMBF (Germany, PI: Henrik Walter) and the respective national funding agencies (PI Canada: Timothy Caulfield) and (PI Finland: Tuija Takala).

For a German Subproject (The Standardized Mind: Implications of Neuroimaging on a Theory of Human Reflective Action) we seek to appoint a Post-Doc Researcher for three years. You will be working primarily on neurophilosophical and neuroethical questions which might also include empirical work using fMRI. You will work primarily in Germany but are expected to work for some months in Canada and Finland with the project partners.
