Clinical Practice Guidelines – Advanced (CPG – As) are published by the Pre Hospital Emergency Care Council (PHECC) to guide the clinical practice of registered Advanced Paramedics.

The CPG – As are recommended by the Medical Advisory Group (MAG) and the Clinical Care Committee prior to publication by Council.

CPG – As are considered best practice for registered Advanced Paramedics.
