



COMMUNITY AGENDAS FOR CONTEMPORARY SOCIAL PROBLEMS

The Third International Conference on Community Psychology will focus on the study of the contributions the diverse community agendas can offer to engage the pressing social problems of the world at the beginning of the XXI Century: a) Economic polarization and impoverization, inequity, mental and physical deterioration, environmental threats. b) Challenges related to virtual communities and the social disparities in the information age. c) Interculturality and its difficulties regarding discrimination, renewed racisms, and migration, d) Politicization of violence and phenomena of insecurity, corruption, impunity and fundamentalisms. We welcome proposals that will offer community agendas in the following areas:

- Critical thinking on Community Psychology in diverse regions of the world.
- Regional and global theoretical trends for the understanding of social and community challenges.
- Higher education and non formal training experiences for social activists.
- Community Psychology practices or interventions in confronting social crises and emergencies.
- Research or evaluation of projects on community agendas related to pressing social problems.
- Public policies and Community Psychology: collaboration and conflicts.
- Ethical challenges regarding community goals and values.
