- to obtain research grants in Dutch and international competitions
- to supervise PhD and Master's dissertations
- to occasionally be involved in teaching in this area of research

Required

- interest and experience in quantitative research, preferably in the area of geographic criminology
- experience in statistical analysis and modeling
- background in geographic criminology, environmental criminology or geography
- publication record of high quantity and quality, i.e., regular publications in peer-reviewed scientific journals
- preferably shown to be able to obtain grants
- preferably has good record in supervision of junior staff and Ph.D. projects
