On a casual basis, as required by local schools, you will deliver talks on a range of subjects that support the National Curriculum to school children across the Borough of Runnymede and surrounding area using objects from the museum's collection and handling collection.



The successful candidates will represent the museum to local schools delivering sessions that last from 60 minutes to 90 minutes per class.

Pay will be £20 per session (most schools are 2 form entry requiring 2 sessions). A petrol allowance of 40p a mile will be paid for every school visit.
