

# Frequently asked questions

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## Q. What is Education Governance?

- A.** An Education Governance framework sets out the commitment, standards, processes and tools needed to help guide and measure the contribution and impact of education in achieving organisational priorities.

## Q. How does Education Governance link with Clinical Governance?

- A.** Education Governance is similar to Clinical Governance in embedding accountability, transparency and continuous improvement into an organisation's culture – in this case within the learning, development and knowledge management function.

## A. Who needs to know about it?

- A.** This is relevant to all NHS organisations with particular reference for all Board-level Directors, Foundation Programme Directors, Undergraduate Clinical Tutors, Learning and Development Agreement Leads, Learning and Development Managers, Practice Education Facilitators, Library Managers – any individual responsible for supporting the delivery of education and learning.



## Q. What are the key components?

A. There are four key components required within an Education Governance framework:

- an Education and Learning Strategy
- a process with self evaluation as its starting point
- an Education Governance Board
- education and learning measures.
