## Frequently asked questions

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#### Q. What is Education Governance?

A. An Education Governance framework sets out the commitment, standards, processes and tools needed to help guide and measure the contribution and impact of education in achieving organisational priorities.

# Q. How does Education Governance link with Clinical Governance?

**A.** Education Governance is similar to Clinical Governance in embedding accountability, transparency and continuous improvement into an organisation's culture – in this case within the learning, development and knowledge management function.

#### A. Who needs to know about it?

A. This is relevant to all NHS organisations with particular reference for all Board-level Directors, Foundation Programme Directors, Undergraduate Clinical Tutors, Learning and Development Agreement Leads, Learning and Development Managers, Practice Education Facilitators, Library Managers – any individual responsible for supporting the delivery of education and learning.



### Q. What are the key components?

- **A.** There are four key components required within an Education Governance framework:
  - an Education and Learning Strategy
  - a process with self evaluation as its starting point
  - an Education Governance Board
  - · education and learning measures.
