The Equality Bill

<u>The Equality Bill</u>, published on Monday 27 April 2009 by the <u>Government</u> <u>Equalities Office</u>, will have legal and practical implications for all higher education institutions.

The Bill proposes a general public duty on public authorities including higher education institutions. The duty will be extended from the current areas of race, gender and disability to include the protected characteristics of sex, pregnancy and maternity, gender reassignment, age, sexual orientation and religion and belief.
