Special Issue on Youth Development Through  
Outdoor and Adventure Education Programs

Principles of positive youth development have long been imbedded in outdoor and adventure education programs, and youth-focused articles are regularly included in the *Journal of Experiential Education*. However, the intent of this special issue is to condense the current understanding of youth development through outdoor and adventure programs and to provide a focused compilation of articles that can provide a foundation for continued work in this area.

*Potential topics for this issue include:*

- ◆ Model building and theory testing involving how and why youth development occurs
- ◆ New or innovative research techniques and/or evaluation strategies applicable to the study of youth development
- ◆ Research-based or evidence-based practices in youth development
- ◆ Youth research on special or diverse populations engaged in outdoor or adventure education
- ◆ Historical, reflective, or theory-oriented pieces that offer insight into current practices
- ◆ Emerging trends or critical issues in adventure and outdoor programs for youth
- ◆ Theoretical and/or literature-based articles that offer new insight for outdoor and adventure programs working with youth
- ◆ Adventure or outdoor program design considerations for fostering youth development
- ◆ Staff training or program implementation considerations for fostering youth development
