

Young Archaeologists' Club



The underlying ethos of the Young Archaeologists' Club is for young people to learn about the past whilst having fun. Research shows our members come from a diverse range of backgrounds and regions across the UK.

Introducing the YAC Pass!

The **YAC Pass** is our members' **Passport to the Past**. It has been running successfully for many years and currently has a large variety of venues across the UK participating. This includes over 160 independent sites and museums, as well as sites in the care of English Heritage, Historic Scotland, Cadw, the Northern Ireland Environment Agency, and Manx National Heritage. The British Museum Company, Costwold Outdoors and the Professional Association of Diving Instructors (PADI) are also involved in the scheme.

Each participating organisation provides YAC members with a special incentive on production of their YAC membership card. These include free or reduced entry, and discounts in site shops.
