Hybridization as a Therapeutic Challenge: Couple and Family Work across Bicultural Divides

Friday, November 20th, 2009 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm

This seminar explores the therapeutic challenges of working with family members representing multiple generations with quite different cultural values. Hybridization of cultural frames of reference influences alliance building, dynamics and strategies in the family therapy context. The identifications and frames of reference are issues evident in the internal and external worlds of the family and the therapist. Reframing and forming alliances to shift functioning of family or couple systems present ethical and empathic challenges. Generational transmission of values and trauma raises interesting dynamic issues, sometimes promoting health and wellness, at other times culture is used as a defence against any reflection or remapping of family or couple options. Clinical vignettes will serve as a path to enter this territory and highlight issues that emerge in proposing strategies for couple and family work.

Speaker: Jaswant Guzder, MD, FRCPC McGill University, Montreal, Canada

Dr. Guzder is Associate Professor in the McGill Department of Psychiatry and Head of Child Psychiatry at the Jewish General Hospital. She is a psychoanalyst and supervisor for the Art Therapy masters program at Concordia University. Dr. Guzder worked in Mumbai, India from 1980 to 1984. Her child and family practice in Montreal is multicultural. She has graduate students working with South Asian and African populations. Her areas of expertise include: Clinical practice with migrant and refugee children and families; borderline pathology in children; culture and psychosis; trauma and bereavement; migration and mental health of Indian immigrants in Canada.


