



Illustrated Children's Books explores the history, design and influence of the most seminal children's books which have inspired and enchanted generations worldwide.

Looking at work from as early as the 1600s through to the golden age of illustration in the nineteenth century, *Illustrated Children's Books* examines the history, development and design of children's books in great detail from the very beginning. From post-World War II progressions in colour printing and the emergence of new illustrative styles in the 1960s and 70s, to the iconic illustrations, stories and characters produced in the last hundred years.

Produced in association with the Booktrust and the Ezra Jack Keats foundation in New York, *Illustrated Children's Books* provides a rare glimpse into the history and provenance of the characters we all know and love. As well as an analysis of more contentious material such as Noddy and Little Black Sambo, explored here in a socio-historical context.

Other iconic characters wandering through the pages of this beautiful book include such perennial favourites as Winnie the Pooh, The BFG, Dogger, The Very Hungry Caterpillar, the Gruffalo, Babar, Miffy and Captain Pugwash amongst many others. Explored in terms of cover design, character illustration and book interiors, these much loved stories are brought back to life again in this richly illustrated, hardback compendium.

Illustrated Children's Books also gathers together the work of critically acclaimed contemporay illustrators, published since 2000, for the first time. Artists such as Polly Dunbar, Emily Gravett, Mini Gray and Oliver Jeffers, who were selected amongst the Top 10 Best New Illustrators by former Children's Laureate, Michael Rosen, and whose beautiful illustrations are set to inspire a new generation of young readers.

Illustrated Children's Books is a bookshelf essential for designers, illustrators, parents and anyone wanting to take a sentimental look back at their childhood favourites.

Anthony Browne is the current Children's Laureate (2009-2011) and is an internationally acclaimed author and illustrator of children's books, with nearly forty titles to his name.

Peter Hunt is Professor Emeritus in Children's Literature at Cardiff University. His books include works of criticism, novels, and stories for younger children. He won the International Brothers Grimm Award for services to children's literature in 2003.

Lisa Sainsbury is Senior Lecturer in Children's Literature at the National Centre for Research in Children's Literature, Roehampton University.
