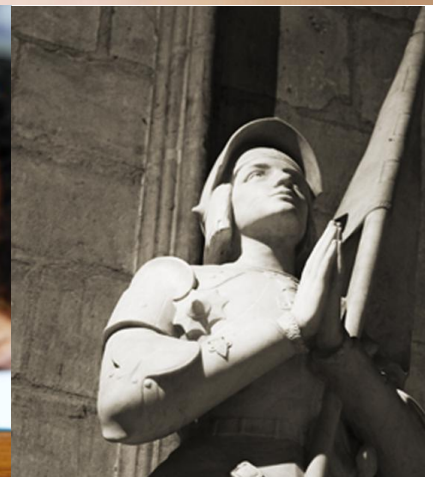


Family Learning Training for Museum Staff
