## **Professor of Structural Geology and Geodynamics**

(W3 salary level, tenured)

The position is to be filled as soon as possible.

The successful candidate is expected to represent the fields of structural geology and geodynamics in research and teaching in full breadth. A research emphasis in the structure and dynamics of the upper crust, neo-tectonics and/or tectonic geomorphology is required, in order to supplement and strengthen the research area "dynamics and transportation processes in the lithosphere". Existing co-operation and projects are to be supported.

Applicants are expected to have an international reputation and outstanding achievements in the field of Structural Geology and Geodynamics. Extensive experience with the acquisition, execution and co-ordination of national and international research projects is expected. Active participation in the academic self-administration of the Faculty is expected.
