The doctoral research of the candidate should focus on one of the following two fields:

. Mozi in the Han: A study that traces how the figure of Mozi and the ideas promulgated in the book *Mozi* continued to persist into the Han dynasty . The revival of Mozi: A study of new interpretations of Mozi after contact with the West: in the Ming, Qing, or the Republican era.

The candidate should hold an MA in Chinese Studies, East Asian Studies, Philosophy, History or a related field at the time the position begins. He or she should be fluent in spoken and written English and Mandarin, and be able to read classical Chinese.

The position is primarily devoted to the achievement of a doctorate, but it also entails some teaching assistance and the occasional administrative duties. The remuneration is decided according to the status of the candidate.
