Every workshop provides ample opportunity for each participant to appreciate their own leadership style, consider how to apply their leadership influence and reflect upon the impact and opportunities of their leadership behaviours, regardless of their job role.

Combining leadership theory, action-based learning, a touch of behavioural psychology and some insightful facilitation, these workshops provide an excellent environment for participants to build a fuller understanding of their own leadership.

The core content of each workshop includes:

- Creating definitions of leadership, management and followership
- Understanding leadership styles; their strengths and weaknesses
- Leading yourself, leading teams and leading in the wider sector
- A psychometric tool to investigate preference, decision-making and diversity
- Building a leadership plan through stories

These workshops will be of benefit to participants who recognise a need to broaden their approach to leading a team, an organisation, projects and even stakeholders – regardless of whether they have a formal leadership responsibility. You might also be interested in tools, tips and behaviours that demonstrate how values and authenticity play their part in leading change.

Through participating in this workshop you will also become part of a network of museum, archive and children's workforce professionals leading in a whole range of cultural settings across England.
