Dissemination and Implementation of Evidence-based Occupational Health Practice

Evidence based OH practice



Great progress has been made in the field of evidence-based occupational health. Perhaps the most high profile example of this has been the establishment of the Occupational Health Field of the Cochrane Collaboration, based in the Finnish Institute of Occupational Health. Other notable examples include the Occupational Health Clinical Effectiveness Unit, funded by NHS Plus, in the United Kingdom and the Centre of Excellence (NVAB) and the Coronel Institute, University of Amsterdam, in the Netherlands.

The challenge now is to change professional behaviour amongst occupational health practitioners to improve the quality of occupational health provided by health services. This workshop will address the need to disseminate the messages within E-B guidelines and to promote their implementation. Participants will take part in two out of four workshops lead by international experts, followed by plenary sessions.

Abstracts are invited for oral presentations or posters. The abstract should be a maximum of 250 words and structured as follows: Objective, Design, Setting, Participants, Main outcome measures, results, conclusions. The authors should be clearly listed, with affiliations and the contact should be highlighted.
