Becoming a Published Academic Writer July 6-8 2010, 09.30-16.30

A summer school for academics, researchers and doctoral researchers in the humanities and social sciences, offering the opportunity for three days of intensive focus on academic writing.

- Work on your own writing with the support of a personal tutor in small learning groups
- Gain a better understanding of the writing process and how to develop a 'writing voice'
- Find out how to get work published in books and journals.

Each day will focus on a different aspect of academic writing, and will include plenary sessions with publishers and leading academic writers.
