

## Call for Research Proposals Open 8th September – 3rd November 2010

The Prostate Cancer Charity invites applications for project grants and PhD studentships from UK based researchers. We fund projects in basic, translational, clinical and survivorship research that are of direct relevance to the lives of men with prostate cancer.

Our Research Strategy clearly details the areas that are of high priority to the Charity; there are four key areas outlined as priorities for funding:

- Strategies for prostate cancer prevention
- 2. Improving diagnosis
- Development of treatments for castrate resistant prostate cancer
- Addressing the wider psychological and social impact of prostate cancer diagnosis and treatment (survivorship)

## **NEW FOR 2010:**

**Survivorship Research Initiative** – we now invite applications for research into the long-term impacts for men living with prostate cancer.

**Pilot Project funding** – we are now accepting applications for the funding of short-term pilot projects.

The upper limit for grant funding – has now been raised to £500,000.
