Funding and Eligibility

AHRC postgraduate studentships provide full awards for part-time or full-time study (UK/EU tuition fees plus a maintenance stipend at nationally-agreed levels) to UK and EU candidates who meet UK residency criteria; other EU candidates may be eligible for a fees-only award.

Applicants must have gained an undergraduate degree from a recognised university, or be a current undergraduate expecting to graduate before 31 July 2011. Those applying for a doctoral award should normally have, or be studying for, a Master's degree.
