Miles Ayling. As Director of Service Design, Miles has policy responsibility for a number of important areas of health service and system design, including Long-term conditions, Urgent & emergency care and the reconfiguration of services in Primary Care Trusts and hospitals. His team helps create the culture and support the infrastructures that allow innovation to flourish throughout the NHS.

Roger Coleman is Professor Emeritus of the Royal College of Art, where he is a member of the Helen Hamlyn Centre's Board of Advisers and on advisory boards for its healthcare research programmes. In 1994 he established a European network specialising in design and ageing, and in 1995 the RCA was awarded a Queen's Anniversary Prize for Higher and Further Education in recognition of his work.

Geraldine Fitzpatrick is Professor of Design and Assessment of Technology and Head of the Human Computer Interaction (HCI) Group at the Faculty of Informatics in the Vienna University of Technology.

Sophie Morgan is UK based artist, writer and designer. Since a car accident in 2003 that left her paralysed and in a wheelchair for life, Sophie's art centres on her experience as both a person with disabilities and as a young woman. Her body of work reflects this; The Mannequal[™] evolved and is the first display product of its kind - a wheelchair for a mannequin.

Alan Newell is Emeritus Professor at the School of Computing, University of Dundee. He has been researching into computer systems to assist people with disabilities for over forty years. His current research is concerned with the technical challenges older people have with the use of technology, and the use of professional arts organisations to raise awareness and facilitate discussion on these issues.
