THE GEOLOGY OF ONSHORE PIPELINES – What are the implications of geology for the Client, Consultant and Contractor in the design and construction of pipelines?

Of all engineering structures pipelines are those most likely to encounter the widest variations in geology. Generally being installed in the more complex zones of the ground profile, that of superficial geology and the uppermost sections of solid geology, pipelines present unique challenges in design, investigation, construction and maintenance. Advances in technology have ensured the quantity and quality of geological data potentially available for professionals involved in pipelines have increased dramatically. How is all this information used? Are there significant cost benefits from the data? Where could further improvements be made?

Commencing with an overview from the insurance industry on how the traditional roles of Client, Consultant and Contractor interact and what information could be used by insurers when looking at pipeline structures. The seminar will follow the experiences of Consultants and Contractors on the challenges they face from desk study to construction including case studies. Finally input from the perspective of the Client, summarising what aspects are to be championed and where improvements can be made.

There will be opportunity after presentations from each sector for questions and answers, each presentation lasting approximately twenty-five minutes.

The speakers are drawn from organisations across the spectrum and include eminent ground professionals from insurance, client, contracting and consulting organisations. The event is likely to be of considerable interest to all professionals involved in pipeline activities.
