



## PERMISSION FOR THE USE OF COVER IMAGES BY LIBRARIES, FROM PUBLISHERS

This document details all the Reading Partners publishers' policies on whether libraries can use book cover images in their promotional material – and who the best contact is to speak to about it.

Most publishers say it is fine to use images without talking to them, so long as libraries use the full image and do not change it in any way. But there are one or two exceptions. Some publishers have webpages set up so libraries can download images of book covers and authors. Other publishers have given us a contact number and name.
