Open Call for Submissions

Polari Journal (www.polarijournal.com) is currently holding an open call for submissions for a special issue (published online June 2011) featuring writing by transgender, transsexual, intersex, androgynous and genderqueer writers, artists, activists and commentators. Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Queer writers may also submit work that features trans characters, lives, culture, or issues.

The special issue will be entitled Trans verse. The "verse" in the titles refers to poetry and prose, as well as to the notion of a transgender universe or world.

Polari Journal is an international, peer-reviewed journal. *Polari* tends towards the shorter forms: **short stories**, *poetry*, **essays**, *one act plays/scripts*, **reviews**, *scholarly works*, **photography and visual art.** In general, the word limit for fiction, plays and essays is 6000 words. Reviews should not be more than 1500 words. For poetry, the maximum is 100 lines.

Academic contributors should have a Postgraduate qualification, or be enrolled in Postgraduate study.

Non-academic contributors should have at least one previous publication (including self-published) and may offer portions of previously published work with publisher's permission.

At this time financial remuneration is not offered. All rights remain with the author/s.

The Final Date for Submission is **April 1st 2011**.
