The Community Engagement Team at London South Bank University invites you to an interactive, hands-on workshop to learn from each other and develop creative solutions for 'Enhancing the Student Experience'.

In light of the Government's recent announcements regarding changes to the regulation of tuition fees, how can we adapt our practices and provision to ensure we are delivering the best service to our students?

How can we maximise our time and effort to deliver more as budgets tighten and resources become ever more precious?

This workshop will be led by University of Manchester Lecturer Dr. Joanne Tippett, who has successfully developed 'Ketso', a hands-on toolkit for effective engagement, into a spin-off company from her research.

The workshop offers an opportunity for participants to experience using Ketso as a toolkit for stimulating dialogue and group discussion, as it is being used in Universities across the UK and beyond.
