VI International Cornelia de Lange Syndrome Conference 2011 Call for abstracts for the Scientific Symposium Wednesday July 27

We invite all participants to submit abstracts for oral presentations for the Scientific Symposium at the VI International Cornelia de Lange Syndrome Conference in Copenhagen on July 27nd, 2011.

Abstracts on all aspects of Cornelia de Lange syndrome are welcomed including: gastroesophageal reflux, behavioural aspects including autism, genetic aspects and the clinical picture.

Submissions will be reviewed by a committee comprising members selected from the International Scientific and Clinical Advisory Committee to the Cornelia de Lange Syndrome World Federation.

Preference will be given to abstracts that present the results of new research.

The abstract must be submitted in English and should not exceed 500 words. It has to be concise and clear, highlighting the most relevant aspects, findings and conclusions.

The abstract should be preceded by the title, followed by the name and contact details of the senior author and then the initials, names and affiliation of all authors.

The abstract should be presented using the headings: Background, Methods, Results and Discussion with six keywords beneath the body of the text.

The organisers are seeking publication of the abstracts in a peer reviewed scientific journal.

The closing date for submission of abstracts is April 29th, 2011.

Presenters will be informed whether their presentation has been accepted by May 16^{th.}

At least one author of each abstract should be registered for the meeting.
