

# PhD student position

We are seeking a highly motivated PhD student for a project with a duration of 4 years (funded by the special research fund, Ghent University) on *error awareness* in ADHD, under the supervision of Roeljan Wiersema, in collaboration with Gilles Pourtois and Marcel Brass. FMRI and EEG will be used to study the spatio-temporal dynamics of error processing in healthy controls and individuals with ADHD.

Qualifications: The successful candidate must have a Master's degree in Psychology (clinical, experimental or neuropsychological) and/or (cognitive) neurosciences at the time the position starts. Previous expertise or training in (cognitive) neuroscience (EEG/fMRI) is preferred.

The position is available immediately. Review of applications will start immediately and continue until the position is filled.
