

Egg Sharing Programme – What Next ?

- 1) Please provide us with a colour copy of your passport or your NHS number.
- 2) Please make sure that you have signed the GP consent form, giving us permission to write to your GP. After your consultation, a letter will be sent to your GP requesting your past and present medical history. You must give your GP permission to provide us with your medical history. It is your responsibility to ensure that your GP replies promptly to this letter.
- 3) As soon as possible please make an appointment with your GP to have the following blood tests performed:
 - Hormone Profile (for FSH, LH, Estradiol)
(NB This test must be carried out between day 2 and 5 of your menstrual cycle)
 - AMH
 - Blood Group
 - Haemoglobin
 - HIV
 - Hepatitis B & C
 - VDRL
 - CMV status (Igg & Igm) not latex
 - Chromosomal Study
 - Rubella
 - ~~Cystic Fibrosis~~
 - Sickle Test (if appropriate)
 - Thalassaemia (if appropriate)
 - Chlamydia screening
 - Gonorrhoea swab
 - HTLV I & II
- 4) If your GP is unable to carry out these tests, the Unit will perform them at no cost. However, you must have a hormone profile taken and we must have received a GP letter prior to the Unit carrying out these tests. Please contact the [redacted] Fertility Clinic [redacted] to make an appointment for your blood tests. Please note that some blood results may take up to 4-6 weeks to be processed. It is important that you let us know as soon as possible if your GP is unable to perform any of the blood tests you require.
- 5) It is your responsibility to ensure that we receive the results of the blood tests performed by your GP. Copies of results must be addressed for the attention of :-
