Possible topics: Cultural space production, building or planning cultures, cultural values in architecture and planning, critical cultural geography, systematic integration of multiple perspective approaches in urban research, and fields related.

Admission conditions: Finished Graduate, Diploma or Master Studies Degree in the fields of urban studies, architecture, spatial planning, cultural studies, landscape architecture, political science, sociology or equivalent studies in Austria or abroad.

Required skills: Foreign languages: English, German and a third language (fluent). Organisational skills in intercultural work, teamwork capacity as well as individual project management skills. The candidate is expected to finish his/her PhD project within the duration of employment at the Vienna University of Technology. The candidate will be involved in teaching activities in planning and architecture. We appreciate applications in English.
