The ideal candidates for these positions will have:

One position is open as a long-term position, although the first contract for both positions will be for one year. The salary will be in accordance with EPFL grade placement policies, and will be in the region of CHF 85,000 - CHF 90,000 (circa €70,000 - €74,000 at January 2012 exchange rates).

The candidates will join a dynamic team of pedagogical advisors and will collaborate with them in:

- Offering in-depth teaching evaluations and coaching to academic staff
- Providing training workshops
- Supporting projects including those using ICT which are aimed at curriculum reform and at enhancing the quality of teaching and learning on campus.
