General Travel and Accommodation Information

The University of London (Senate House) is located in the Bloomsbury area of London. Please see here for a map of the University of London's central precinct: <u>http://www.london.ac.uk/fileadmin/documents/home/map.pdf</u>

Senate House is easily accessible by London Underground (Tube). The following lines and stations service the Bloomsbury area: Northern Line (Warren Street, Goodge Street, Euston), Piccadilly Line (Russell Square), Central Line (Tottenham Court Road), Victoria Line (Warren Street, Euston) and the Metropolitan, Hammersmith & City and Circle Lines (Euston Square). The nearest train stations are King's Cross, St. Pancras International and Euston. When selecting accommodation, it is best to look within this area.

<u>By Rail</u>

Euston, St. Pancras International and King's Cross are all within walking distance. Other mainline stations (Charing Cross, Fenchurch Street, Liverpool Street, Marylebone, Paddington, Waterloo, Victoria) are a short Tube journey away.

<u>By Air</u>

Heathrow: Piccadilly Line to Russell Square (approx 45 minutes)

Gatwick: Regular National Rail services or the Gatwick Express (approx 30 mins) to London Victoria. Victoria Line London Underground to Warren Street or Euston.

Luton: Regular National Rail services from Luton Airport Parkway to St. Pancras International (approx 30 mins).
