

### **ABSTRACTS**

Time and effort spent constructing a clear, concise, and well-written abstract will maximize the chances of paper acceptance. New and significant work is a prerequisite for paper acceptance. The abstract body should be between 250 and 350 words and it must include a brief background, methods, results, and conclusion(s) where appropriate. (The online submission system will not allow submission if the maximum number of words is exceeded). Please submit text only. References, tables, figures and special characters are not permitted.

#### **POSTERS**

Poster sessions will be scheduled for poster presenters to be able to answer questions regarding their projects. Title should be in bold. Author's affiliations and e-mail addresses for corresponding authors should be included. Body of the poster should start with a short introduction followed by methods, results and conclusion(s) clearly indicted. Text should be kept to a minimum, and each block of text should include no more than a few sentences. Suggested font sizes are main title: 78-96 pt (bold, upper case), author(s): 72 pt (bold, title case), affiliation(s): 48 pt (normal, title case), subheading: 36 pt (bold uppercase), body of text: 24 pt (normal). Posters may only be submitted via e-mail (as an MS-Word attachment) to icot@iatour.net, no later than May 25, 2013. Posters that are selected will appear in the book of abstracts
