Opening Doors 2012: Moving on from Care

Keele University, working in partnership with Staffordshire University supports a full day event to raise awareness of National Care Leavers Week, highlighting the challenges facing young people leaving care and entering University life.

As part of Keele and Staffordshire Universities' commitment to diversity and incorporating the Care Leavers' Foundation annual Care Leavers' Week, the universities are holding a day of talks and events. The aim is to highlight the challenges facing young people leaving care who want to enter university and inform our University Communities of issues facing care leavers and other young people unsupported by family.

The week starts with an information stand and **giant interactive 'snakes and ladders'** game highlighting the ups and downs of leaving home and starting University and the additional challenges faced by care leavers. The stand will be in the Keele Students' Union reception for the beginning of the week.

On the morning of Wednesday 24th October, Keele will host a day of activities for Education and Social Services staff, foster carers and young people offering an experience of university life and learning. This will be followed by lunch and a range of talks for visitors and university staff and students on the experience of care leavers in Higher Education and the work of the Staffordshire Through Care Team and Virtual School Programme.
