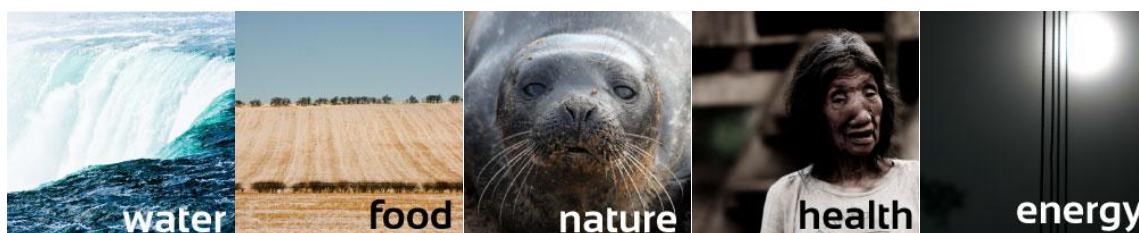
A transdisciplinary symposium for postgraduate researchers
